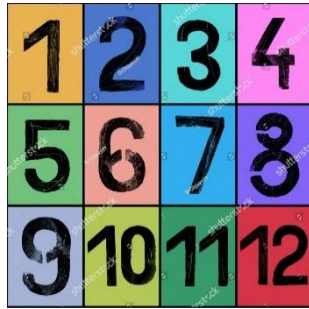
PE:

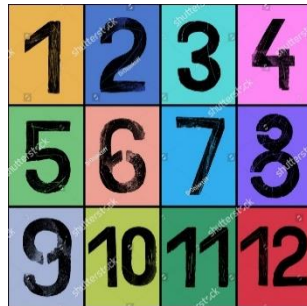


Art/DT:

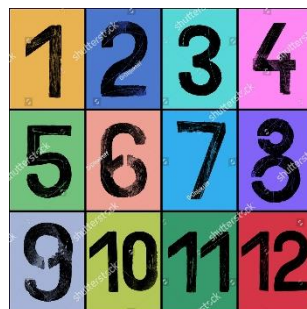
PSHE:
