RE	Gift tag activity sheet	<p>WALT: Explain why gifts are special and important</p> <p>Have you been given a gift that is special to you? Who gave it to you? How did you feel when you received it?</p> <p>Write a gift tag to attach to your special gift.</p>
PSHE	Gingerbread activity sheet	<p>WALT: Identify similarities between people in my class</p> <p>We are all have similarities and differences. Can you think of three things that are similar to your friend? Write them on the gingerbread man.</p>
Art	Paint	<p>WALT: To know the primary and secondary colours and to experiment with colour mixing.</p> <p>Explore the colour wheel.</p> <p><i>What are the 3 primary colours? Can you label them on a piece of paper?</i></p> <p>Experiment with colour mixing the primary colours on your hands. <i>Example: left hand red, right hand yellow and then mix the two to create orange.</i></p>
